

- (2) Affix embroidery stabilizer to the wrong side of outside fabric 1, and then sew your favorite embroidery.





Mark the center of the fabric, and then sew embroidery with a size no larger than 9 cm/ 3.5 in x 9 cm/ 3.5 in.

Decorate outside fabric 2 with stitch patterns. Fold 1 cm/ 0.4 in only at the top of the area where the zipper will be attached.

③ Attach the zipper to the inside fabric.



Place the zipper on the right side of the inside fabric, and then sew along the center of the zipper tape. Do the same on the left side of the zipper.

(4) Spread out the inside fabric, place the outside fabric on top so that it hides the previously sewn stitching, and then stitch along the edge.



Materials

Outside fabric 1 (front)	20 cm/7.9 in x 23 cm/9.1 in – 1 piece
Outside fabric 2 (back)	20 cm/7.9 in x 23 cm/9.1 in – 1 piece
Inside fabric	20 cm/7.9 in x 23 cm/9.1 in – 2 pieces
Seam binding fabric	14 cm/5.5 in x 4 cm/1.6 in – 2 pieces
Grosgrain ribbon	10 cm/3.9 in – 1 piece
Zipper	20 cm/7.9 in – 1
Stabilizer	20 cm/7.9 in x 23 cm/9.1 in – 2 pieces
Embroidery stabilizer	1 piece
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① Affix stabilizer to outside fabric 1 and outside fabric 2. 1 ⑤ With a 1 cm/ 0.4 in seam allowance, sew together the bottom edges of the two pieces of outside fabric and inside fabric

> Fold the seam allowance of the outside fabric toward the back, open the zipper, and then stitch to press down the seam allowance.



Pull the outside toward the inside to form a tubular shape.

(6) Attach ribbon at each end of the zipper.



Cut the 10 cm/ 3.9 in ribbon in half, fold in half, and then attach it with the fold toward the inside.

⑦ Turn inside out, fold flat, fold edges into the center, and then mark.



Fold so that each center touches one side of the ribbon attached in step (6).

(8) Stitch along each folded end, 1 cm/0.4 in in. Trim the seam allowance to even it out, and then wrap it with seam binding fabric to finish it.



Turn right side out to complete the project!
